- Ken, W9GA, mentioned F2 Forward Scan from March QST in the World Above 50 mhz column. He indicated there is a formula in the article to calculate band openings.
- Jerry, N9AW, said K9GS requested a link on the website to the DX Code of Ethics. Their graphic is on the GMDXA website as a link to their site. They have requested our support to engage the ARRL to support the DX Code of Ethics.
- ➢ KJ9I, Dave, said that his 30/40 beam is down. Thanks to the club members that provided help on this project. The antenna has a high SWR on 40 mtrs. He will rebuild the antenna and call for assistance to get it back up.
